32 MRSA 1105:

Nothing in this chapter may prevent a person from making electrical installations in a single family residence occupied by him as his bona fide personal abode, providing that the installation conforms with the standards of the National Electrical Code. Any electrical installations made under the authority of this paragraph after July 1, 1987 in a newly constructed residence, shall require certification by a state or local inspector, master electrician or limited house wiring electrician prior to the activation of electricity by the utility company.

Certification of the National Electrical Code is needed for new construction of a single family dwellings and/or new services and may be certified by a master electrician, limited house wiring electrician, or your local electrical inspector.

If an owner of a single family dwelling chooses to do his or her own wiring he or she MUST get certification from one of the above mentioned before the utility company will provide power.

The form on the reverse side should be completed, pay the fee to the Town of Lincolnville and return to the Town Office after the wiring is complete.

If you would like your premises inspected by the Local Inspector a minimum fee of \$ 50.00 will be due along with you permit application form. This fee will cover up to two hours of inspection. An additional \$ 25.00 per hour will be charged for extra time subsequent inspections.
