**CERTIFICATION OF THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE**

32 MRSA 1105:

Nothing in this chapter may prevent a person from making electrical installations in a single-family residence occupied by him as his bona fide personal abode, providing that the installation conforms to the standards of the National Electrical Code. Any electrical installations made under the authority of this paragraph after July 1, 1987 in a newly constructed residence, shall require certification by a state or local inspector, master electrician, or limited house wiring electrician prior to the activation of electricity by the utility company.

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Certification of the National Electrical Code is needed for new construction of single-family dwellings and/or new services and may be certified by a master electrician, limited house wiring electrician, or your local electrical inspector.

If an owner of a single-family dwelling chooses to do his/her own wiring, he/she MUST get certification from one of the above-mentioned professionals before the utility company will provide power.

The form on the reverse side should be completed by the homeowner (if homeowner is doing electrical work), or by a master electrician or limited house wiring electrician (if they have been hired to do the electrical work), and the appropriate fee paid to the Town of Lincolnville. The Town will forward the application to Central Maine Power Company.

Once the homeowner has completed the wiring, he/she should contact the Town Office to set up an inspection by the Town of Lincolnville Electrical Inspector.

A minimum fee of \$50 will be due with your permit application form. This fee will cover up to two hours of inspection. An additional \$25 per hour will be charged for extra time/subsequent inspections.
