**1. Workshop with Islesboro Board of Selectmen**

Arch Gillies welcomed all in attendance and those in attendance gave introduced themselves.

Members of the two Boards discussed the ongoing Harbor Study by Collins Engineering.

Selectman Gerry inquired as to the greatest need of the Islesboro concerning Lincolnville's harbor. Town Manager Anderson and all of the Islesboro Selectmen present agreed that the public safety issue of a narrow inclines with trap chutes that inhibited emergency stretcher access was the greatest concern.

Other items discussed included but was not limited to: water depth, dredging, condition of floats, more float space, winter maintenance (snow and ice removal), a parking garage, shelter, wave break, cleats, space concerns between dock and mooring field (particularly with NW winds), and parking in general.

Islesboro Selectman Pendleton and Lincolnville Selectman Durity are to work together to gather information on an incline wide enough to safely handle an emergency stretcher and associated items. Each Selectman is to report back to their respective Board.

The Boards discussed how the Town of Islesboro manages its two harbors and harbor related facilities along with the Islesboro harbor budget and Islesboro harbor fees (none).

The Boards agreed by consensus that more routine get togethers could be mutually beneficial and to have the Islesboro Town Manager and Lincolnville Town Administrator to work to establish a schedule for a subsequent meeting (hopefully within a month).
