**1. Workshop with Islesboro Board of Selectmen:**

Janet Anderson, Islesboro Town Manager, provided the Board with a tour of the two owned marine facilities.

The Board meet on Islesboro with the Islesboro Board of Selectmen. Items discussed included but were not limited to:

- Recent repairs made to the Lincolnville wave screen
- The possible upcoming harbor study – Islesboro users are considered a stakeholder and should be interviewed by any consultant. Islesboro would like to participate on every level. Islesboro Selectmen Gillies thought it reasonable for Islesboro to pay their fair share based on data.
- Increasing the donation from the Town of Islesboro
- Emergency, Commercial and Recreational use of the Lincolnville facilities by Islesboro – school use
- The situation with the stretcher and the ramps. Islesboro has abandoned the skid idea as this is not the preferred by their public safety officer. They would like to see a wider ramp for walking with or with the grocery slide. Do we need grocery slides on all three ramps? Discussion was had about alternate float arrangements, such as turning one sideways and having two ramps access it (the current one and a wider one).
- The condition of the floats, float replacement, tie-up spots, and deck replacement.

Upon returning to the Lincolnville the Board toured our facilities.
