

To the Town of Lincolnville Select Board:

re: 2025 Roadside Tree Inventory of Rt. 1 through our town

The Lincolnville Conservation Commission has completed its Inventory of noteworthy trees and shrubs that lie in the Public Way along Rt. 1 as it travels through Lincolnville, from the Northport to the Camden Town lines. The overall distance this document covers is approximately four miles, running northeast to southwest.

The inventory documents tree species, general health, size, GPS locations, notable roadside trees ~ 8" diameter and larger, as well as shrubs and plantings in landowners' dooryards. It documents the roadside canopy in an organized survey, such as the those that many other towns/cities conduct.

The Conservation Commission asks that this document be filed with the Town as it will be a useful tool in maintaining and monitoring its roadside tree canopy along Rt. 1.
