

Here is a breakdown of the bins to help you sort!

These are not dyed (they look gray to opaque) therefore can be sold to a wider market.	These must be food & beverage cans. Please no scrap metal. There is also a mailbox for recycling **EYE GLASSES, CELL PHONES & HEARING AIDS.**
Please **NO** batteries!

Other sorting opportunities at your facility:

Demo Wood Waste – wood generated from demo and construction. This is used as fuels at licensed boilers. Please be aware that pressure treated wood and plastic “wood” must go to the landfill as neither can be legally burned!

Bulky metal – it’s simple, it’s metal! Items with refrigerants are collected separately so the freon can be removed

Sheetrock – this includes both new and painted sheetrock but it is **ONLY** sheetrock!

Brush and Branches – we are developing a local market to use this waste as clean biomass for fuel.

Lead Acid and Rechargeable Batteries – these batteries are consummately recyclable and need to be so! They are loaded with metals and must be recovered for re-use. Please ask at the gate house. Alkaline batteries are now mercury free and can be put in yellow bag.

Many various Electronics – Please ask at the gatehouse!
